This includes mechanical systems, heating and air conditioning systems, fire suppression and detection systems, emergency/security systems, electrical, plumbing, building envelope and lock systems. The bureau's primary focus is to maintain our facilities, conduct preventive maintenance and conduct quality and timely repairs in support of the Department's overall mission.

What We're Looking For:

Full or part time student at a college, university, or technical institute, with a study in the common field or interest in construction or maintenance. The ideal candidate must be hardworking with a desire to work in a rehabilitative environment where you can help put your skills and experience to good use while working in an environment that is challenging and rewarding.

What You'll Do:

During your internship with FDC you will work closely with maintenance staff while gaining knowledge in general maintenance, plumbing, electrical, cabinetry/carpentry, masonry, welding, drywall, roofing, air conditioning and associated systems necessary to operate a major institution. Your internship will also provide on the job training to those inmates he/she supervises in the trades associated with the referenced systems.
